When folk are first learning about Tarot they often prefer to concentrate on the 22 powerful cards that belong to the 'Major Arcana'. Over the coming year we will explain the common meanings of the cards. Decks do differ, so the running order of the cards or name variations may occur. But generally speaking decks start with The Fool; often this card is labelled as 0 or is left unnumbered.

These meanings are meant to give you the beginnings of Tarot, but if you are having a Tarot reading with one of our psychics then they will explain the significance of the cards in relation to your own life, the meaning of the cards will also be interpreted based on the spread being dealt, the other cards chosen and the position of the cards...

The Fool (0)

In Tarot not all cards are literal, and The Fool is one such example, this card really represents new beginnings. With fresh starts you are often buoyed with enthusiasm, and so this card characterises that optimism and excitement. It is likely when you start a new venture that some will disparage your plans. Rather than ignoring these comments, don't be 'foolhardy', check your plans are rational and feasible before ploughing ahead, so that you don't rush into things without properly thinking them through - leading yourself into dangerous ground.



The Magician (I)

There are two possible meanings to this powerful card. Firstly the card may represent a person entering your life who will be influential - but keep in mind the card is called 'magician' and as such there may be trickery or deception afoot. The second meaning is where the card actually represents you! Perhaps you are underestimating your skills and abilities? You are more powerful than you believe... You are equipped with the talent, but now you must find a way to release your competencies and fully express what you are capable of.



The High Priestess (II)

This is a fantastic card for those with a growing psychic gift, the card is letting you know you must trust your gut - go with your intuition, your instinct will not steer you wrong. Spiritual messages are being sent to you, but you need to be more open to receiving them through your dreams or otherwise. The High Priestess is a card that often shows when you are in a position of trying to better yourself, perhaps through formal study or some sort of other learning experience. This is a spiritual and transformational time - you will learn much about yourself and life in general.



The Empress (III)

The Empress can mean many different things - you could be moving house, perhaps you have a call to spend more time outdoors, a pull towards nature. Generally the card is about fertility, creativity and abundance. Fertility could be literal in the sense of a birth of a child, but also could be about cultivating land. Equally it could be the birth of an idea... The card coming up is both favourable and positive - a good outcome in your life is expected.



The Emperor (IV)

The Emperor is seen as a stern card, but is not necessarily negative. This card represents authority, most likely that some sort of authoritative figure will be over you - this could be because of an increase in social standing, or through a new job. The card means restraint should be showed - you need to stay calm, but is also about battle. Do not be afraid of standing up for yourself, sometimes you need to stick to your guns! Often this card characterises someone in your life who you trust implicitly - who is reliable, has a lot of influence, and will do the right thing.



The Hierophant (V)

If you are independent and high-spirited then you may struggle with this card, as it is all about doing things in a tried and tested way. Now is not the time for being brave and maverick in behaviour - it is telling you there is a need to play by the rules and follow tradition. This card often comes when your life is out of balance on a spiritual level and it is time to look at a greater meaning and search for spiritual purpose. This card can also represent someone in your life; in this case they would be conformist, conservative, dependable and steadfast and likely have strong faith.



L&L Flower Meanings

Spring-time is a fantastic time to get back out into the garden, hopefully the worst of the frosts are over; the March Equinox (sometimes called Vernal Equinox or Spring Equinox) takes place on the 20th representing a time of re-birth and of course the clocks go forward on the 26th March, meaning longer days are on the way.

You can use early spring to plan your flower beds and look at what you want to grow in your garden this year. Even if you don't have a garden, you can still grow plants in-doors, use a kitchen windowsill or a small outdoor space like a patio with planters.

Flowers have hidden special meanings, and in times gone by bouquets could be used to convey a certain message particularly amongst loved ones. Once you know the meanings, whether you are planning on planting a flower bed, or picking out a bunch of flowers, you can communicate a whole series of thoughts and feelings through each bloom you pick - like a living letter.

Roses
When it comes to roses you really only want red - for passionate love, white is really a refusal, a sign that they do not love you and yellow means your affections are misplaced.
