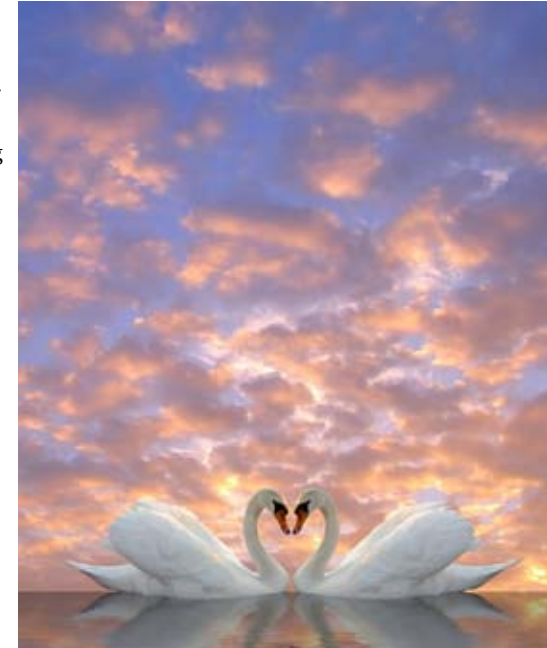
Have you found your soul mate?

The Meaning of the Death Card



Many people avoid having a tarot reading done because they are afraid of seeing the card of Death. There are many others that have had a Tarot reading done and the Death card was in their spread and now are writing a will, or moping around mourning for their loss. It is very important that you have some understanding of what the cards mean.

Typically you will see the Card of Death with a skeleton, black robes or armour. You may also see the Death Card as a flag with a white rose pictured on a black and desolate field. There can be a rising sun and there could be other figures on the field, many times you will see a child. The proper name for the Death Card is Arcana; it does not mean a physical death. So if this card pops up, you do not have to prepare for your funeral.

What Arcana, the Death Card, actually means is that there a symbolic death taking place, this can be transformation of sorts. Usually when this card comes into a spread it is telling the person that it is time to make some changes, or that there are changes happening which they cannot control, but that they are going to need to adapt to. This "death" is necessary for growth. We all experience these "deaths" throughout our lives we just don't see a Death Card forewarning us.

There is a story that goes along with the Death Card, as there is for every card in the Tarot deck.

Here is the story of the Arcana:

It is said that the Fool left the tree he was hanging from he begins to walk through a fallow field, his head still clearing from the visions he saw as he hung from the tree. The cold and wintry air and the bare trees, then he sees before him a rising sun, and a skeleton all dressed in black riding a white horse. The Fool asks, "Have I died?" The Fool is feeling empty inside. The Skelton answers back, "Yes in a way. You have sacrificed your old world, your old self. Both are gone, they are dead." The Fool says, "How sad," and the Skeleton agrees and says, "Yes, but it is the only way to be reborn. A new Sun is rising, and it is, for you, a time of great transformation." Death rides away and the Fool is left, feeling the truth of what the Skeleton has said. He begins to feel like a skeleton himself, stripped of everything. It is then that the Fool understands that this is how great transformation begins; you are stripped to the bone so that you can build anew.

This is not to say that the Death Card never means a physical death under the right circumstances, the right circumstances being a person that is very old or very sick. Death is a transformation, from a lower state to a higher state, Arcana is the signal for transformation or passage or change.

Scorpius is the sign associated with this card, and it has three faces or forms, the scorpion, serpent and eagle. Arcana is the card of humility, so it can also mean that this is a moment of low, when it feels as though all is lost so that you can rebuild and go to a place that is higher than where you ever were before.

\$64 Million Dollar Question: How Much Money Do You Need To Be Happy?

Most of us have probably bought a scratch card or lottery ticket or gambled in some way hoping to win the big prize, and with recent news stories awash with Euro Lottery winners taking home their cheques for £50+ million it's hard not to dream about that being you one day!

According to the National Lottery website the current odds for winning the euro millions jackpot (5 main numbers & 2 lucky stars) is 1 in 76,275,360. So with the odds probably not in our favour on beginning the next big winners how much money do we need in ordinary day to day life to feel happy? Perhaps not as much as you might think!

The Easterlin Paradox is a concept in economic happiness; it is named after an economist Richard Easterlin who discussed the factors contributing to happiness in a 1974 paper titled "Does Economic Growth Improve the Human Lot?" Essentially it explains that rich people tend to be happier than poor people but that rich societies as a whole do not tend to be happier than poor societies.

In July 2010 the Joseph Rowntree Foundation reported that a single person living in the UK needed to earn at least £14,400 a year before tax in order to achieve a basic but acceptable standard of living. For a couple with two children this figure jumped to £29,200. People that took part in the research did not just take into account necessities such as food, warmth and shelter, but looked beyond that to things that enabled them to participate in society so things like computers and internet connection, a weeks holiday, the ability to buy birthday and Christmas gifts, as well as an element of modern convenience – fridge freezers, mobile phones and so on.

The New Economics Foundation – Centre for Well-being demonstrates at lower levels of income such as £15,000 there is strong link between income and well being. However as moves are made up the income scale the link dissipates, so although people get happier as they become wealthier – it only happens up to a point.



Meaning beyond that point no matter how much money is made the person will not become any happier. So in theory what you are actually looking for is enough money so that you do not have to worry financially, but not so much that you will not be sensible with your hard earned cash. Although there are varying opinions on just what this level is most studies believe the relationship between money and happiness stop between £24,000 - £27,000. This means that any money beyond this marker will have minimum impact on your happiness levels and that you will need to seek out happiness in other areas of your life such as your relationships, family, health and rewarding work.

As I write this article today there is a piece on the Daily Mail website about a young woman called Callie Rogers who won nearly two million on the lottery just aged 16. She had a difficult life up to that point and she hoped the money would turn things around for her but in fact it made it worse, she suffered with drug problems and made several suicide attempts. Having spent most of her money admittedly probably unwisely she is now on the mend and down to the last £100,000 is the happiest she has ever been – a cautionary tale perhaps?

Perhaps the best argument for only needing so much money to be happy is the recent spate in philanthropy with 34 US billionaires pledging at least 50% of their wealth to charity either prior to or on their death. Bill Gates (second on the Forbes list as worlds richest people) and Warren Buffett (3rd on the list) started The Giving Pledge to persuade hundreds of U.S. billionaires to give away most of their fortune during their lifetime or after their death and to publicly state their intention with a letter of explanation – with a minimum 50% of their wealth to be pledged. So far New York Mayor Michael Bloomberg, entertainment executive Barry Diller, Oracle co-founder Larry Ellison, energy tycoon T. Boone Pickens, media mogul Ted Turner, banker David Rockefeller and investor Ronald Perelman have signed up.

Only you can decide what level of income you need to lead a fulfilling life and I have to confess I will probably still take part in the occasional lottery draw!

Exploring the Psychic World

True Psychics

A true Psychic should be able to give you helpful information without you giving them any information except your name. However, in order to get the exact kind of information you want from a Psychic you are going to have to ask them some questions in order for them to have some idea what information will prove most helpful to you.

Many times people in their eagerness to find help will ask their questions in such a way as to indicate the answer they want to hear. This is what most fakes are hoping for as it gives them information on which to base their so called reading. In cases where you may be speaking with a genuine psychic your questions may indicate a direction that may affect their ability to give you an accurate reading.

For that reason many people often ask what questions should I ask a Psychic? The answer is that you can pretty much ask them whatever question you choose. It is not the question you ask but the way you ask it that is important. For example, if you suspect your husband is cheating on you and you want to know if that is the case. You should phrase your question in a way that does not reveal your suspicions. Instead of asking if your husband is cheating you might ask instead "Is there something standing in the way of my husband and I being as happy as we should be?"

By not asking the specific question regarding cheating, you leave the answer open and therefore if the psychic confirms your fears

you know that it is not because this is an answer you suggested to them.

The same is true when asking career advice. Don't ask a psychic if you will be getting a promotion ask them instead where they see your career heading.

When first speaking with a new psychic, you may even want to ask them some test questions to see if they are really legitimate. By asking general non informational questions if they are able to tell you that you are married and have two children and that is correct you know that the person has true psychic abilities. However, if they start asking you questions then they are fishing for hints on what to base your reading on and you should walk away.

It is also wise to prepare your questions in advance that way you can keep the time you spend talking to the psychic directed towards the questions you need answered instead of having the session focus on the past. Psychics can be helpful but, they are also expensive so keeping focused on those issues you want to resolve will not only make you happier with your reading but, will give you the help you need.

So, go ahead ask your Psychic any question you want and get the information you need. Just make sure that you ask the question in a way that gives them no information into your own personal thoughts or desires so that you will know that the reading is true and therefore is something that can actually help you make the decisions you need to make.
